
# REPORT FROM HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER

The Highway Department maintains the residential streets and public right of way in unincorporated Orland Township. This includes repair and construction of streets, storm sewers, sidewalks, curbs and street signs.

### **POTHOLES & PATCHING**

Winter months and snow plowing can cause potholes within the roadways. If you see a pothole which we did not fill, or have road-related questions or concerns, please call the Highway Department at 708-403-5148 and provide us with the location.





### SUMP PUMP DISCHARGE

It is unlawful to discharge any sump pumps onto Township sidewalks and roads. The standing water exacerbates pavement deterioration and creates an ice hazard in winter months. Drain hoses should be directed to the natural ditch between homes so that water will follow grade.
