POTHoles AND PATCHING



Winter months and snow plowing can cause potholes within the roadways. If you see a pothole which we did not fill, or have any road-related questions or concerns, please call the Highway Department at 708-403-5148 and provide us with the location.

SUMP PUMP DISCHARGE

It is unlawful to discharge any sump pumps onto Township sidewalks and roads. The standing water exacerbates pavement deterioration and creates an ice hazard in winter months. Drain hoses should be directed to the natural ditch between homes so that water will follow grade.

TVs/MONITORS - All types (flat screen or glass tube) do have a cost to recycle. Please see the information below for cost based on device size. Payment will be taken at the gate prior to recycling (CREDIT CARD ONLY).
