

**MINUTES OF THE INAUGURAL MEETING OF THE
DECENNIAL COMMITTEE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY ACT
OF THE ORLAND TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT**

The inaugural meeting of the Decennial Committee on Local Government Efficiency Act of the Orland Township Road District was called to order by Highway Commissioner Antonio Rubino at 3:33 p.m. at the Orland Township Highway Department building.

No members of the public were present and accordingly no public comment was made at the meeting.


Attorney Melissa Wolf presented information regarding the establishment and purpose of the Decennial Committee and components of information to be contained in a report of the Committee required under the Decennial Committee on Local Government Efficiency Act.

Highway Commissioner Antonio Rubino and members Pam Davis and Maurice Russo discussed the initial goals of the committee.


The Committee also reviewed and discussed the sample report prepared by the Township Officials of Illinois, and the contemplated information to be contained in the report including information regarding intergovernmental agreements and how governmental efficiency has increased by these agreements. The Committee discussed pending intergovernmental cooperation between the Road District and other governmental entities on various matters and included the Road District / Township's current practice surrounding consolidation of employees for insurance and payroll and the need for the continuation of that cooperative practice via an intergovernmental agreement.
