SPRING PERMITS

SUMP PUMP DISCHARGE

It is unlawful to discharge any sump pumps onto Township sidewalks and roads. The standing water exacerbates pavement deterioration and creates an ice hazard in winter months. Drain hoses should be directed to the natural ditch between homes so that water will follow grade.

Turn in your unused or expired household prescription medication for safe disposal. Medications should be in a sealed plastic bag or original container.

NOT ACCEPTED

- Needles/Syringes
- Lancets/Injection Pens
- Liquids/Medical Waste
- Chemo/Cytotoxic Drugs
- Contaminated Materials
- Batteries
- Aerosol Spray Cans
- Trash/Hazard Waste
- Illicit Drugs (Schedule 1 Substances Marijuana, Cocaine, Heroin and Methamphetamine)
